

Library Services:

Circulation Services:

The Library at Sanskriti University extends membership to all students, research scholars, faculty members and staff. Upon receiving their Identity card cum Library membership card, they are entitled to borrow books and other reading materials. This popular service is facilitated through the computerized circulation system, which only allows book issuance upon presentation of the Library membership card cum Identity card.

Inter-Library Loan (ILL) Service:

The Sanskriti University, Library provides the Inter-Library Loan (ILL) service through DELNET Centre which enables users to borrow books and journals from other libraries. In case of unavailability of required material, users may download the Inter Library Loan form from the Library's website and send their requests to library@sanskriti.edu.in. Reproduction of research articles is also arranged through this service.

Library Orientation Service:

The Central Library conducts user orientation/user awareness services (education programs) every year at the beginning of the academic session to familiarize students and faculty members with its systems and services. Apart from this, the program covers various topics related to academic and research work from time to time.

Reprography and Computer Printing Services:

Reprography and computer printing facility is available to all users from 09:30 AM to 04:30 PM on all working days at a flat rate of Rs.0.00/- per page. The Library only reproduces material required for personal research and study purposes.

Current Awareness Service:



The Library provides Current Awareness Service (CAS) through email alerts, notice boards, social networking sites, etc.

Web OPAC services:

The Sanskriti University, Library offers Web OPAC services that allow patrons to browse its collection of documents through the web-based library online catalogue (KOHA Web OPAC) from Link: http://digital.sanskriti.edu.in/.

Cyber Library Service:

The Cyber Centre provides workstations for accessing online resources such as e-journals, e-books, online lectures and other useful materials available in electronic form. Patrons can also attend conferences, workshops, seminars, etc. through Webinar.

Reference Service:

The Central Library provides reference tools such as dictionaries, encyclopedias, subject-related books, Swami Vivekananda Collection, religious books, novels, fiction, general books, Harvard Corner, new arrivals, manuals, competition materials, Hindi collection, English collection, motivational books, autobiography, yearbooks, atlas, biography, handbooks, and bibliography. Separate reading rooms are available for students, faculty members, and research scholar students.

Periodical Section Service:

The Central Library has a separate Periodical Section for students, faculty members, and research scholar students. This section contains journals, magazines, newspapers, CD/DVD, thesis & dissertations, reports, etc., which can only be referred to inside the library. The Library also provides services such as Binding, Text Book, Library Newsletter. Digital Institutional Repository, Borrowing Facilities, Overdue Alert Email Service, Auto Email Alert after Every Check-in/Check-out items, NPTEL e-Learning Facility, SWAYAM and SWAYAM Prabha, NDLI etc.
